RISE will be owned and operated by the Rockaway Waterfront Alliance (RWA), a community-based nonprofit organization focused on connnecting local families and schoolchildren to better appreciate and respect the waterfront. Now in its 10th year, RWA has served over 5,000 students and familes across the Rockaway peninsula. RWA's graduating classes of students and interns have a 95% rate of college enrollment and acceptance in STEM-related fields. 

## Floor Directory



The 2ND FLOOR will house conference & event rooms; a computer lab and kitchenette, will be available for lectures, classes and programs. This space can be used for both RWA programs as well as other local community group programming.

The MEZZANINE will hold a cafe area & working kitchen and serve as host space for both cooking classes and to cater events.

The OUTDOOR TERRACE and WIFI LOUNGE will be a casual meeting place. This will be open to the general public.

The **1ST FLOOR** will house an art gallery with curated exhibitions focused on art, science and the environment. The space will hold high-end AV equipment for film screenings and art installations. This space can also be used for public gatherings and events.
