






### History of the Rockaway Freeway/Elevated train




In 1941 construction began for the elevated track of the LIRR train to Far Rockaway. A temporary ground level rail sat just to the south of the elevated track during construction. This would soon be replaced with the new elevated track for LIRR completed in 1942.





















### The Rockaways: Health Issues



The Rockaway's have 1 of the highest obesity rate according to a community survey administered by NYC DOH




### New York City: Community Health Survey

"The Traffic Data Viewer (TDV) is an interactive map program that displays published traffic data graphically. On the interactive map individuals have control of displaying data for individual traffic stations, the type of data available, and the location of counters used to collect the data. Estimates of Annual Average Daily Traffic (AADT) are available graphically for segments of roadway that contain a traffic station. Traffic Volume Reports containing hourly data are also available for most traffic stations. The data displayed by the TDV is collected by the Continuous Count and Short Count Programs. Counts are taken across the State of New York on an annual basis at approximately 8,000 to 10,000 locations per year. The data then undergoes quality control procedures before it is used to calculate AADT and other factors. As such, the most recent data displayed by the TDV will be for the previous year. 






- » Improve commute and connectivity





#### **Knowledge is Power:**


Permanent tenant spaces occupied by a non-profit education and research center, which includes demonstration farms and community garden space for local residents.









